
## \*\*\*Upgrade to General Class License\*\*\*






### Hans Jens Estate Donation:



## Double whammy on the sun

A spectacular double eruption on the sun was captured today by NASA's <u>Solar Dynamics</u> <u>Observatory</u>. The eruptions happened nearly simultaneously on opposite sides of the solar disk, <u>SpaceWeather.com reported</u>. The plasma clouds produced by the event are expected to miss Earth, so there's no threat to us or to satellites orbiting the planet.

On the lower left in this image of the sun, a magnetic filament erupted, and on the upper right a departing sunspot produced the strongest solar flare of the year so far.
