There have been no issues that involve the trustee administration function.

Despite having control of the VHF and UHF repeaters, the Tech Team is investigating methods of getting the repeater site connected to the internet. Having such a connection would allow for much more than the present simple control. Possibilities include monitoring repeater parameters, local weather, and video monitoring. Expanding this to an ancillary or supplemental link from w8lap.com would give members, and the general public, access to the measured information. Further, a control web page would give control functions to those authorized to perform them.

To this end, if you (or if you know someone willing to support our efforts) live closer than four miles from the repeater site, and wouldn't mind us using a few kB of your web connection, let me know - or bring it up at the next meeting.

A Ham Radio Video - From the Heart

This video, made entirely by Corliss Kimmel, AL1G, is unlike any with a Ham Radio theme that I, or several who have reviewed it thus far, have seen.

Corliss resides in Anchorage, AK, and has been involved in radio for some time. She is well known as an active contester, using both CW and phone. Additionally, her late husband Frank Hurlbut (KL7FH - SK 2008) was also very active in HF contesting. 


