# Secretary's Report

#### **Lapeer County Amateur Radio Association - Meeting Minutes - September 13, 2016**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by President Gordon KD8TXW. There were 21 members and guests present.

#### Presentation

The presentation of the evening was the Hawaiian adventure of Jim, KB8TXZ, Greg, N8GAS, and Doug, N8VY. They described the trials and adventures of putting National Parks on the Air, Volcano National Park, on the big island of Hawaii. Beautiful scenery, government bureaucracy, radio station performance and power solutions were highlighted.

#### EC Report

#### Repeater Report

There was an issue of low audio being transmitted through the 2 meter repeater. The repeater team traced it down to a poor audio connection passing through the PL tone decoder board. [And re-soldered it!]

Another issue reported was poor link quality (hiss) on the 220 link to North Branch. The repeater team traced this to a poor RF connection at the rear of the 220 link radio. Further tests were done to determine if the link antenna's direction was off the mark. Will, KB8YGA erected an auxiliary 220

beam antenna on a portable tower and determined that the link antenna and direction were not part of the weak signal phenomena.

#### Operation CARE

No report was available on the Labor Day donations. Tom, KD8EBY has announced his intention to retire from the post of Operation CARE coordinator as of Labor Day 2017.

#### Old Business

Dan KC1BUD offered metal roof building materials for the repeater shack. Tea and Crumpets need to be assessed and times straightened out in the Waveguide and the website.
